



MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP **FRANCO BUZZI**



Every year, the Franco Buzzi Memorial Scholarship offers deserving and talented young people the opportunity to attend one of the most prestigious education programs in the United States.

With this year's program, the initiative has further evolved. Alongside the well-established MBA programs, graduate degrees in other disciplines (Master of Science programs) have now been added, expanding both the academic offerings and access to high-level educational opportunities.

BENEFITS

Each year, Buzzi awards two scholarships to the sons and daughters of employees (and retirees) from all of the Group's countries, as well as to graduates who earned a high school diploma in Casale Monferrato, enabling them to pursue a master's degree at selected leading U.S. universities.

The selected master's degree programs are full-time and will be fully funded by Buzzi. The scholarship covers not only tuition, but also standard ancillary expenses such as travel, accommodations, health insurance, books, and other eligible costs.

Each year, Buzzi will fully fund two full-time master's degree programs with a maximum duration of two consecutive years. If a selected program offers multiple completion options (e.g., 12, 18, or 24 months), Buzzi will cover the full tuition cost regardless of the program length.

Reimbursement of living and other eligible expenses, however, will be limited to the minimum duration established for the selected program.

Scholarship funding will be provided in two ways:

- Payment made directly to the university to cover tuition costs.
- Reimbursement paid to the student for duly documented eligible expenses, such as books, housing, health insurance, travel, and other approved costs.

MASTERS' PROGRAMS' ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet the admission requirements established by each university, which may include:

A bachelor's or other qualifying university degree.

Proficiency in English, demonstrated by TOEFL, IELTS, or Cambridge English test scores (not required for U.S. citizens or permanent residents, or for applicants who have earned a degree in an English-speaking country).

A satisfactory GRE or GMAT score, where required. Other factors considered during the admission process may include:

- Relevant work experience (primarily for Master of Business Administration [MBA] programs).
- Academic achievement and intellectual ability.
- Determination, results orientation, communication skills, maturity, integrity, and leadership potential.
- Participation in extracurricular, volunteer, and community activities.

For additional admission requirements, applicants should consult the websites of the individual universities.

SELECTION PROCESS AND DEADLINES

Master's Degree Programs

To ensure transparency and uphold the principles of merit-based selection, Buzzi will not participate in or influence the universities' evaluation and admission process.

Applicants must submit their applications directly to the selected university through its online application system by the deadline established for the chosen program. The entire admission process is managed exclusively by the university.

Franco Buzzi Scholarship

To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must submit to the designated Buzzi contact a copy of the documentation provided to the university as part of the admission process. If necessary, additional documentation may be requested during the scholarship evaluation process. Applicants may also be asked to participate in an interview.

Scholarship applications must be submitted to Buzzi by one of the following deadlines:

- By June 1st
- By December 1st

Applicants will be notified of the scholarship decision approximately four weeks after the applicable deadline, subject to the timing of the university's admission decision.

Applicants may apply for the scholarship before receiving confirmation of admission to a master's degree program. However, the scholarship can be awarded only after the applicant has been accepted by the university.

If more than two applicants admitted to one of the eligible master's degree programs apply for the scholarship, the final recipients will be selected based on merit and qualitative assessments, at Buzzi's sole discretion.

BUZZI CONTACT PERSONS

Each applicant's designated contact is the Human Resources Director in the country where the applicant's parent is currently employed or was last employed by Buzzi.

Applicants are required to notify their designated Human Resources Director by email when they apply for admission to the selected university or universities and again upon receiving confirmation of admission.
